#### RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS MINUTES OF MEETING DECEMBER 12<sup>TH</sup>, 2007

The Medina Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Medina Township Hall on December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2007, to conduct the business of the Township. President Todd called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm with the following Trustees in attendance: Dianna Huffman, Michael D. Todd and Mead Wilkins. Also in attendance were the Fiscal Officer, Police Chief, Fire Chief, Road Foreman, Assistant Road Foreman, Zoning Inspector and the general public.

#### Roll Call

Mr. Todd asked for a roll call of all members present. Trustees present were Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

Mr. Todd led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Todd motioned to open the floor for public comment. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion.

Unknown male asked if the public would be able to speak later.

Mr. Todd motioned to close the floor for public comment. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion.

#### Approval of Accounts Payable

Mr. Todd motioned to approve accounts payable checks #18190 to #18238 totaling \$267,937.82. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### Approval of Payroll

Mr. Todd motioned to approve payroll checks #11603 to #11651 totaling \$30,562.60 with deductions totaling \$3,255.17. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### Approval of Minutes

Mr. Todd motioned to approve the minutes for the November 29, 2007, regular meeting as presented to the Board with the handwritten change made by Mr. Todd. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### Mark Herwick - Homestead Insurance-Hospitalization Renewal

Mr. Herwick of Homestead Insurance presented the Trustees with the new hospitalization plan and cost. The benefits will remain the same with a savings to the township of approximately \$15,000.00. Mr. Todd explained the Health Savings Account plan and the savings to the township.

Mr. Todd motioned to approve the change in our health care plan from the PPO1590 to the SuperMed Plus HSA2500 Plan as presented (see attached) to the Medina Township Board of Trustees. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd, Mr. Wilkins.

Mr. Todd motioned to terminate the dental plan with Humana Dental. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

Mr. Todd motioned to terminate the life insurance and short term disability policy with Fort Dearborn Life. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### Revised Project Cost for Maintenance Building

Mr. Illes presented Trustees with a revised project cost for the Maintenance Building. The deductions that were removed save the township \$186,800.00. The final project cost will be \$701,350.95. This is without the salt shed. That will be done at a later date.

Mr. Wilkins motioned to accept the revised bid from Illes Architects for the price of \$701,350.95. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### REPORTS

#### Zoning Department

Elaine Ridgley reported that for the month of November 2007, 22 zoning permits were issued as follows:

For a total value of permits issued \$1,493,000.00. Fees collected were \$2,535.39.

#### **Road Department**

Ed Kerr reported that for the month of November 2007, the road department cleaned and maintained equipment and vehicles; installed, repaired and replaced signs as needed; picked up yard waste dumped in River Trace Subdivision; filled in washout hole on Nettleton Road bridge; rebuilt plow wheels on #14 plow; took truck #11 for repairs; installed a catch basin and drain pipe at FS#2; cleaned up leaves around complex; repaired complex sign light; repaired berms on Hood, Lake Forest and Substation; received salt delivery; winterized irrigation at Blakslee Park; trimmed trees along roads; responded to 2 daytime fire calls.

Mr. Kerr discussed the culvert on Nettleton Road. A letter will be sent to Mike Salay requesting Issue I monies to replace the culvert.

Mr. Wilkins asked when the cemetery driveway will be finished. Mr. Kerr said it would be finished in the spring.

#### Fire Department

Chief Crumley reported that for the month of November 2007, the department responded to 43 calls for service. The breakdown of location of these calls is as follows: Medina Township, 12 Medina City 27 and Montville Township 4. (See attached) Chief Crumley asked that homeowners be sure their smoke detectors are working. He suggests they also have fireplaces, woodburners or space heaters checked before using them.

#### Police Department

Chief Arbogast reported that for the month of November 2007, the Police Department responded to 734 calls for service. (See attached) December 15, 2007, the department will take 12 children shopping with Shop with a Cop.

Mr. Todd motioned to accept departmental reports. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### Medina Hospital/LST

Mr. Wilkins gave an update regarding Township concerns with University Hospital acquiring Medina General Hospital and the continuance of the Life Support Team. He spoke with Gene Sulzener, Director of the Life Support Team, and was told University Hospital and the Life Support Team are sharing information at this time. Gary Hallman, President of Medina General Hospital, will be sending Trustees a letter regarding this matter.

#### Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee

Mr. Wilkins said the Trustees will hold a workshop regarding this matter.

#### Comprehensive Plan Contract

Mr. Todd tabled this item until we hear from Mr. Thorne.

#### Lease/Purchase Police Vehicles

Mr. Todd explained about the Fleet Lease for police vehicles and how it will save the township money.

#### **Brush Fire Truck**

Chief Crumley said they received approval from Mr. Thorne regarding the GSA purchasing system to purchase a brush fire truck for \$130,000.00.

#### Resolution No. 12122007-034

Mr. Todd motioned to put forth the following resolution to approve the expenditures not to exceed \$130,000.00 for a brush truck as incorporated by this document dated December 12, 2007, from the Medina Township Fire Department. (See attached) Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

Mr. Todd motioned to approve Chief Crumley and Trustee Huffman to sign on behalf of the Board of Trustees for the purchase of the vehicle with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Forestry GSA Federal Purchasing System. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

#### Resolution for Soil and Water Conservation District

Mr. Todd spoke with Jeff Van Loon and was told the Trustees proposal regarding Route 3 was put before the Soil and Water Conservation District Board. They will hold a meeting in January 2008, and the township will be able to voice their concerns regarding this matter.

#### Conservation Easement

Mr. Todd tabled the Conservation Easement. The township is waiting to hear from Mr. Thorne regarding the wording of the document.

#### Park District

Mr. Wilkins has exchanged phone calls with Tom James and a decision has not been made at this time.

# Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Forestry GSA Federal Purchasing System Activity Code Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, hereinafter referred to as the DIVISION, and the Medina Township Fire Department FDID# 52-121 fire department, firefighting agency, private fire company, or fire association, hereinafter referred to as the FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the prevention and control of fires in <u>Medina County</u> is of mutual concern to the DIVISION and FIRE DEPARTMENT; and the FIRE DEPARTMENT can more adequately carry out this function if additional equipment is available, and

WHEREAS, the DIVISION pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 1503.011 through the Department of Natural Resources, is authorized to participate on behalf of the State of Ohio in such agreements; and the Division has the authority, as identified in section 203 of the Department of Agriculture Organic Act of 1944 (16 U.S.C. 580A) and in accordance with current interagency agreements between the Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, The General Services Administration, the US Army and others, to recommend the FIRE DEPARTMENT to the USDA Forest Service for access to the Federal Purchasing System to purchase fire protection equipment and supplies, and The parties to this memorandum of understanding do hereby agree as follows:

### THE DIVISION AGREES TO:

- 1. Make recommendation to the USDA. Forest Service that the FIRE DEPARTMENT be authorized access to the GSA Federal Purchasing System to purchase fire protection equipment and supplies.
- 2. Monitor purchases of the Fire Department pursuant to AGREEMENT guidelines.

#### THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AGREES TO:

- 1. Purchase ONLY fire protection equipment and supplies meeting NFPA standards
- 2. The Fire Department assumes all responsibility for ordering said fire protection equipment and supplies and for payment of such supplies in full. The Fire Department agrees that the State of Ohio or any of its affiliates is not responsible for payment or reimbursement of such fire protection equipment or supplies purchased.
- 3. For auditing purposes, a copy of all orders placed must be sent to:

ODNR - Division of Forestry Fire Supervisor 4045 Morse Rd. H-1 Columbus, Ohio 43229-6605

- 4. Submit to the Division a quarterly report of all wildfires within their jurisdiction. This report should include information on location of fires, fire sizes, fire dates, cause, fuel type and number of structures threatened and/or destroyed.
- 5. Not discriminate with regard to race, creed, color, sex, disability, handicap, age, or national origin in performance of this agreement.
- 6. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this AGREEMENT may result in immediate cancellations of the provisions outlined herein.

#### EFFECTIVE DATE OF AGREEMENT

This agreement shall be effective beginning the date of last signature hereon. Any previous agreement(s) between the two parties are hereby rescinded effective the date of last signature hereon.

#### **TERMINATION**

This agreement will be effective from date of execution and will continue in force unless terminated by either party upon ninety (90) days written notice.

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

Obligations of the State are subject to the availability of funds as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 126.07.



#### Medina Township Inventory Management Policy

In order to safeguard the tangible assets of Medina Township, the following policy is hereby adopted:

The Medina Township Trustees or their designee shall maintain a current list of all inventory items as defined by this policy.

A tangible asset is defined as equipment, vehicles, furniture, tools, appliances or any other item purchased by the township that has a useful life of three or more years with an original purchase price of \$200 or greater. Consecutively numbered inventory stickers will be utilized, and each asset must be tagged with this identifying number. Each township Department Head will be responsible for assuring that the tags are affixed properly and are easily visible. If an asset has several components, the Department Head and Fiscal Officer will jointly make a determination as to whether one or multiple inventory tags should be utilized.

A computerized list of inventory items will be maintained with the inventory number, description of the item, purchase price, township department, and location of the item. The Trustees will annually provide each Department Head with a list of inventory for his/her department. The inventory is to be performed on the second Monday of January of each year as required by O.R.C. Section 505.04. The Department Head will then insure that all items on the list can be located as shown. The Fiscal Officer or any Trustee may also perform random inspections at any time to further confirm the accuracy of the inventory list.

No asset that is on the list may be disposed of without action by the Board of Trustees. Disposition of inventory will be in accordance with O.R.C. Section 505.10.
