

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS  
MEDINA TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES BUDGET WORKSHOP  
FEBRUARY 28<sup>TH</sup>, 2014**

The Medina Township Board of Trustees met in special session on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014, to conduct the business of the Township. Mr. Todd called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm with the following Trustees in attendance: Michael D. Todd, Ken DeMichael and Ray Jarrett. Also in attendance were the Fiscal Officer, Fire Chief, Police Chief, Road Foreman, Zoning Inspector and the general public.

**Roll Call**

Mr. Todd asked for a roll call of all members present. Trustees present were Mr. Todd, Mr. DeMichael and Mr. Jarrett.

**Fire Department Budget**

Trustees and Chief Crumley went over the numbers for the Fire Department line by line. Mr. Todd asked that the following statement be put on the record. Chief Crumley said that \$15,000.00 will work for his repairs and maintenance.

**Road Department Budget**

Trustees and Denny Miller, Road Foreman, went over the budget numbers for the Road Department. There was discussion about the repair of fields at Blakslee Park. These would include regrade of baseball fields one (1) and two (2), regrade and install drainage on soccer field B. Mr. Todd said Medina Soccer Association is discussing building a full size field house (80x100feet) on soccer field B paid for by the Soccer Association. The Township would then own it and would lease it back to MSA. Mr. Miller said MSA would rent it out for other sports and the Township would get back some of the profits. Mr. Jarrett asked if we would be responsible for maintenance of the building. Mr. Todd said those are items that need to be discussed by MSA and the Board of Trustees. He brought it up now so they could decide whether to allocate monies for soccer field B. Mr. Todd said it is purely an idea and he told Mr. Jones it would have to be discussed by the full Board.

**Police Department Budget**

Trustee and Chief Arbogast discussed the Police Department budget. Trustees were able to allocate monies for a garage at the new Police Department


**Administration**
