

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
DECEMBER 21st, 2017
7:00 PM**

The Medina Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Medina Township Hall on December 21st, 2017, to conduct the business of the Township. Chairman Ostmann called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the following Trustees in attendance: Bill Ostmann, Ray Jarrett and Ken DeMichael. Also in attendance were Fiscal Officer Ventura, Police Chief Arbogast, Road Superintendent Miller, Zoning Inspector Ridgley and the general public.

Roll Call

Mr. Ostmann asked for a roll call of all members present. Trustees present were Mr. Ostmann, Mr. Jarrett and Mr. DeMichael.

Pledge

Mr. Ostmann led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Mr. Ostmann asked for a moment of silence for our service members both here and abroad and for our first responders who risk their lives every day to keep us safe

Approval of Accounts Payable

Mr. Ostmann motioned to approve accounts payable checks #28798 through #28832, total amount \$53,223.95. Mr. Jarrett seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Mr. Ostmann aye, Mr. Jarrett aye and Mr. DeMichael no.

Approval of Payroll

Mr. Ostmann motioned to approve payroll checks #23688 through #23710. Total amount \$36,714.42 with \$6,993.13 deducted for taxes, OPERS, union dues etc. Mr. DeMichael seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Ostmann, Mr. DeMichael and Mr. Jarrett.

Mr. Ostmann motioned to approve the November bank reconciliation. This is one of four pages, I mean it is four pages and I will incorporate it by reference. Mr. DeMichael seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Ostmann, Mr. DeMichael and Mr. Jarrett.

Purchase Order Requisition for OTARMA Liability Insurance for 2018

Mr. Ostmann motioned to approve a purchase order requisition and the vendor is OTARMA and the department is Admin and this is for our contribution for liability insurance and the total amount is \$70,044.50. Mr. DeMichael seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Ostmann, Mr. DeMichael and Mr. Jarrett.

Mr. Jarrett motioned to approve the Fire Department, Police, Road and Bridge and Zoning reports for the month of November. Mr. Ostmann seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Jarrett, Mr. Ostmann and Mr. DeMichael.

DEPARTMENT HEAD COMMENTS

Police Department

Chief Arbogast said the annual Shop-with-a-Cop was held on December 16 and they took approximately 150 children. He thanked Mr. Radice for helping with the children. They had breakfast and lunch at Blue Heron and then shopped at Wal-Mart.

Chief Arbogast said they have been working on theft offense cases and found three houses were involved, one (1) in Medina Township, one (1) in Brunswick and one (1) in N. Ridgeville. Ours was the largest. They removed approximately 240 boxes of literally thousands of items from the three locations and they are beginning to sort through them. He thanked Denny and the Service Department for their help in transporting the property. He also thanked the BCI Agents, N. Royalton, Brunswick and Montville Police Departments and the drug task force. Forrest Thompson, County Prosecutor was there to be sure everything we were doing was legal. Mr. Jarrett asked if indictments were to follow and the Chief said yes. Mr. Jarrett asked if the individuals can skip town and the Chief said that is possible.

Service Department

Mr. Miller said he had spoken to each Trustee and asked for permission to lend Sharon Township our backhoe while theirs is in for repairs. Mr. Ostmann motioned to loan our backhoe to Sharon Township for approximately the next two (2) weeks while their broken down backhoe is being fixed so they can load salt in the trucks and keep their streets safe. Mr. DeMichael seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Ostmann, Mr. DeMichael and Mr. Jarrett.

Office for Older Adults Report

Sally Gardner said there will be a New Year's Eve Party at the Office for Older Adults on the last Friday of the month. AARP income tax preparation can be scheduled beginning in January 2. 
Ed Schwartz (3918 Remsen Road) asked how many people in the Township receive those benefits. Mrs. Gardner said she can get those figures for next meeting.
