- Your car contains fluids that allow it to function properly. When these fluids leak, much bigger problems may occur. Fixing a small leak now may prevent big car repair bills in the future.
- Fluids in your car are extremely toxic. Fix leaks so children & pets don't play in toxic puddles or drink toxic fluids.
- When it rains the fluids from your car flow into storm drains, then to local rivers & streams that drain to bigger lakes & oceans.
- Local and migrating wildlife rely on a healthy waterways for their survival.

Car Wash Woes:

Did you ever wonder where the soapy water goes when you wash your car in the driveway?

- Water drains off impervious (hard) surfaces into the road, then into the storm drain.
- Most storm drains go directly to local streams without any treatment.
- Car washing facilities are required to dispose of their used, polluted water responsibly.
- If you wash cars at home, try washing on the lawn. This allows water to be absorbed and filtered before it goes to local streams.
