RESOLUTION # 0502 2019-016

Relating to a Moratorium on Enforcement of Zoning Setback, Parking, and Landscape Requirements Where Nonconformities Result from Governmental Taking of Property

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Transportation is constructing a project to widen and reconstruct 2.13 miles of S.R. 18 from just west of Alber Drive in the City of Medina to the intersection of Nettleton Road in Medina and Montville Townships, Medina County. A 10' multi-use path will be constructed on the south side of S.R. 18 from Woodland Drive to Nettleton Road. Additionally, a new structure over the west branch Rocky River will be constructed for the multi-use path. New storm drainage and traffic signals will also be installed. (the "Project"), which involves acquisition of additional right-of-way along State Route 18, River Styx Road, and Foote Road ("governmental action") for the Project, and

WHEREAS, this governmental action may affect a particular property owner's compliance with requirements relating to the landscaped area between the right-of-way and the developed portion of the site, the minimum number of parking spaces, parking area setback, signage and fencing setback from the right-of-way, and the use of temporary lighting during construction, as set forth in the Medina Township Zoning Resolution ("Zoning Resolution"), and

WHEREAS, this governmental action *may* place property owners along State Route 18 from Foote Road to Nettleton Road, and Foote Road, through no fault of their own, in a non-compliance situation with respect to the Zoning Resolution, which the Board of Township Trustees feels would unfairly burden affected property owners, if required to restore their properties to full zoning compliance, and

WHEREAS, the residents and businesses of Medina Township, as well as the traveling public, will greatly benefit from the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's improvements along State Route 18 from Foote Road to Nettleton Road, and Foote Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEDINA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT:

Section 1. This Board declares a moratorium upon enforcement of zoning requirements relating to the landscape area between the right-of-way and the developed portion of the site, the minimum number of parking spaces, parking area setback, signage and fencing setback from the right-of-way, and the use of temporary lighting during construction along State Route 18 from Foote Road to Nettleton Road, and Foote Road for properties affected by the State of Ohio

Department of Transportation's Project.

- Section 2. It is the finding of this Board that any property owners along State Route 18 from Foote Road to Nettleton Road, and Foote Road affected by the acquisition of additional right-of-way by the State of Ohio should not be unfairly burdened with the additional expense of correcting zoning violations created by this governmental action.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Pursuant to this moratorium, properties adversely affected by the State of Ohio's acquisition of additional right-of-way for this project shall be deemed legal nonconforming properties under the Zoning Resolution.
- <u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall not be deemed to constitute an amendment to the zoning resolution or a waiver of the zoning resolution requirements except as to the issues directly arising from the acquisition of additional right-of-way in the Project area.
- Section 5. The Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of the Board, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Medina Township Cemetery Rules

- 1. The Cemetery is open to the public from dawn to dusk every day.
- 2. Agents appointed by the Board, consistent with the Ohio Revised Code, shall enforce all cemetery rules and regulations.
- 3. Upon death of the recorded owner, the control of the unused or under-designated grave/s shall go to the legally designated beneficiary/s. If none is so designated, the ownership shall follow the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 4. Children under the age of sixteen must be under adult supervision while in the cemetery.
- 5. Loitering is not permitted.
- 6. The speed limit within the cemetery is 5 MPH.
- 7. Visitors shall observe good order while in the cemetery. Loud talking, loud music, excessive vehicle noise, or any other type of disruptive behavior is not permitted.
- 8. Vehicles must remain on pathways at all times.
- 9. Animals and pets are permitted in the cemetery so long as they comply with the Dog Control Resolution of Medina Township.
- 10. Township employees or agents of the Township shall perform all labor. This includes, but is not limited to, placing of monuments and markers, construction of concrete foundations, excavating and backfilling graves, trimming trees and shrubs and mowing grass. Any item placed in the cemetery that is inconsistent with these rules and regulations, or that has not been approved by the Board, shall be removed without notice.
- 11. No person shall remove any flowers, trees, shrubs, or bushes without the permission from the roads superintendent.
- 12. All gravesites are required to have, at minimum, a footer. Medina Township does not regulate the materials of grave markers.
- 13. The recorded owner/s of the grave/s is permitted to place flowers or decorations, consistent with these regulations, within a 2- foot area immediately adjacent to the corner and in front of each headstone. Decorative wreaths are also permitted.

- 14. The recorded owner/s of the grave/s shall be the controller in respect to the placement, care, and maintenance of flowers and/or decorations on the grave(s).
- 15. Trees, bushes, shrubs, vines, and landscape timbers are not permitted to be placed on or around gravesites.
- 16. Any flower or decoration deemed unsightly will be removed and discarded. Any object/s that is determined by the Roads Superintendent to be obstructing the general maintenance of the cemetery shall be removed immediately.
- 17. In the event that a Medina Township employee or agent damages a grave marker or monument, Medina Township will repair the damage. However, Medina Township will not be responsible for any article placed at a gravesite, or within the cemetery, that is not a grave marker or monument established or associated with the gravesite.
- 18. Medina Township shall endeavor to keep the cemetery grounds secure to every extent practical but the Board, any employee, or any other agent of the township shall not be responsible for any items that are stolen or vandalized, other than property owned by Medina Township.
- 19. Cemetery records shall be kept at Medina Township Hall and are available by contacting the Township Secretary.
- 20. Snow Plowing in the winter will be done on an as needed basis and is dependent on the needs of the Township.
- 20. Items of food left on a grave/s shall not be permitted.
- 21. Any violations of these rules and regulations are subject to a penalty consistent with the Ohio Revised Code

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH REGISTRATION OF TRANSIENT VENDORS

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code under the authority of Section 505.94 grants Township Boards of Trustees by resolution, the power to enact registration regulations of Transient Vendors, and

WHEREAS, there are transient vendors within Medina Township, and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to reasonably regulate the <u>TIME, PLACE AND MANNER</u> in which these vendors may sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders for future delivery of goods, and

WHEREAS, the Board has the power to further adopt reasonable registration fees.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

Medina Township shall adopt a Transient Vendors Resolution under the following terms, rules and conditions:

- 1. <u>All Transient Vendors</u> who do business within the Township of Medina, Medina County, Ohio shall register with the Township, at the Medina Township Hall 3799 Huffman Road Medina, Ohio 44256.
- 2. A Transient Vendor means or is defined as any person who opens a temporary place of business for the sale of goods or who, while on the streets, roads, or highways found within Medina Township or while traveling about Medina Township, sells, offers for sale, or solicits orders for future delivery of goods where payment is required prior to the delivery of the goods, except that Transient Vendor does not include under person who represents a business or organization, including but not limited to, any entity exempted from taxation under Section 5709.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, that first notifies the Board of Township Trustees that its representatives are present in Medina Township for the purpose of selling, offering for sale or soliciting orders for future delivery of goods, or an auction company licensed under Section 4707 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 3. The Medina Township Trustees shall maintain a registration log where all Transient Vendors shall register at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to their coming into Medina Township to sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders for their goods. The registration can be made between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- 4. <u>Transient Vendors</u> shall be permitted to sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders, door to door, or location to location:
 - a. between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays.
 - b. between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Saturdays and **NO SOLICITATIONS ARE TO BE MADE ON SUNDAYS OR HOLIDAYS.**
- 5. <u>Transient Vendors</u> shall make a payment of \$25.00 for their registration fee at the time they register at the Townhall. All payments shall be in cash in the exact amount of \$25.00 or money order made payable to Medina Township. (Also see item seven (7) for multiple Transient Vendors)
- 6. <u>Transient Vendors</u> shall be required to fill out an application at the time they register. The application form shall be filled out in person by each Transient Vendor.

- 7. Each individual person who sells, offers for sale, or solicits orders for goods shall be required to register according to this Resolution even though he may be one or more of several Transient Vendors who sell, offers for sale, or solicits orders for goods for the same group, company, or other business entity. Each separate Transient Vendor shall be required to separately and individually pay the \$25.00 registration fee provided in item five (5) above even though he is one of several persons who sells, offers for sale or solicits orders for goods for the same group, company or other business entity or entities, or firms.
- 8. The registration period shall be valid for ninety (90) days and shall commence on the date of application.
- 9. All companies, corporations businesses or business entities shall provide to their Transient Vendors, to be given to the Township Trustees, a written statement signed by a person with authority that the Transient Vendor is in fact authorized to sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders for its goods within Medina Township for it, or under its authority or agency.
- 10. Any Transient Vendor application or log that contains false or untrue information shall give the Township cause for that registration to be canceled and it shall be grounds for prosecution under Section 505.99 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 11. <u>Transient Vendors Working at a Fixed Location.</u> All Transient Vendors who sell, offer for sale, or solicits orders for future delivery of goods where payment is required prior to delivery or goods, who establishes a temporary place of business within Medina Township, shall in addition to the other requirements mandated herein:
 - a. establish the temporary place of business in an area zoned for the same. No temporary place of business shall be established in areas zoned residential.
 - b. not violate any Township Zoning Regulations in regards to signs.
 - c. not sell, or offer for sale, or solicit orders for future delivery of goods between 9:00 p.m. and 8 a.m.
- 12. Any Transient Vendor who violates any of the terms, conditions, or requirements of this Resolution shall be subject to prosecution under Section 505.99 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 13. Any Township Trustee, or Chief of Police, or his designated officer in charge during his absence or being otherwise unavailable, shall have authority to take actions to terminate, cancel registrations, or initiate prosecution under item ten (10) and twelve (12) above.
- 14. Should any one or more parts of this resolution be adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any Court or other body or person empowered to so rule, it shall not invalidate any other parts or sections hereof.
- 15. The term "he" as used herein shall refer to both the female and male gender.
- 16. No Transient Vendor shall together with, or in combination with, twelve (12) or more persons who are Transient Vendors, operate within Medina township at any one time, whereby they are all selling, offering for sale, or soliciting the same goods
- 17. No Transient Vendor shall open a temporary place of business that is in derogation or violation of any Township Zoning Resolution.

- 18. All Transient Vendors shall appear in person at the Medina Township Townhall 3799 Huffman Road Medina, Ohio 44256 to notify us that their activity under their registration is completed and terminated. The Medina Township employee who receives this information shall so note it in the "log" of Transient Vendors.
- 19. The Transient Vendor log shall be a public record open for inspection.
- 20. This Resolution shall be effective within thirty (30) days of its adoption after proper publication. Those in violation are subject to the penalties of Section 505.99 of the Ohio Revised Code. the Board of Trustees shall establish the administrative mechanism to implement this Resolution, including but not limited to, briefing Township employees and establishing log and application files.
- 21. Transient Vendors shall not sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders for goods where the dwelling, property, building, or other structure has made notice by means of a sign that its owners or occupants do not want salesmen, or solicitations, or transient salesmen or vendors, and such a sign is reasonably calculated by its size and placement to notify the Transient Vendors of this fact. An example of this, but not limited to this, are signs that say "NO SALESMEN or "NO SOLICITATIONS".
- 22. All "Medina Township" identification signs at the entrance to the Township that are maintained by the Township shall have placed upon them by the Road Department a sign reasonably calculated to inform the passerby in a vehicle or otherwise traveling: ALL TRANSIENT VENDORS MUST REGISTER AT THE MEDINA TOWNSHIP TOWNHALL.
- 23. The Fiscal Officer shall notify the Medina County Prosecutor of this Resolution and its conditions pursuant to Section 505.94 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 24. Notification is required to be made by exempted businesses or organizations under this Resolution and Section 505.94 of the Ohio Revised Code, to the Township Trustees in writing, that its representatives are present in the Township for the purpose of selling, offering for sale, or soliciting of orders for future delivery of goods or an auction. Such notification shall be addressed to the Board of Trustees and a record of all such notices of exempted businesses or organizations will be kept in a log.
