



Section 1. The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Medina Township and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, and:

- a. The purpose of said tax levy is to provide ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both as set forth in Section 5705.19(U) of the Revised Code.
- b. The tax shall be a renewal of a levy of one and one-half (1.50) mills for each one-dollar of valuation which amounts to fifteen cents (\$0.15) for each one hundred dollars of valuation and a decrease of one-half (.5) of a mil for each one-dollar of valuation which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, that portion of the levy that was added at the November 8, 2016 election and commenced in 2017, for a resulting total renewal of one (1.0) mill.
- c. The submission of the question of said renewal levy and decrease is authorized by Sections 5705.03, 5705.19(U), 5705.191, 5705.192, and/or 5705.25 of the Revised Code.
- d. The term of the tax shall be for five (5) years (see Section 5705.19).
- e. The territory where the tax is to be levied shall be the entire territory of Medina Township, Medina County, Ohio.
- f. The date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot is November 2, 2021.

- g. The territory where the ballot measure is to be submitted is the entire territory of Medina Township, Medina County, Ohio.
- h. The tax year in which the tax will first be levied is 2022 and the calendar year in which the tax will first be collected is 2023.
- i. The Township has territory in Medina County and in no other county.

Section 2. This Board requests, in accordance with Section and 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, that the Medina County Auditor certify to this Board the following:

- a. The total current tax valuation of the Township, and
- b. The dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal levy with decrease specified in Section 1.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 5705.03(B)(1) the Township Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the Medina County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board or committees, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AND INCREASE A MEDINA TOWNSHIP POLICE, FIRE AND, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND RELATED EXPENSES LEVY.

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the tenmill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Medina Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Medina Township, Medina County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Medina Township and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, and:

- a. The purpose of said tax levy is for all purposes set forth in divisions (I) and (J) of Revised Code Section 5705.19, that is for police, fire. EMS and related purposes, as provided in Revised Code Section 5705.19(JJ).
- b. The tax shall be a renewal of a levy of one and four-tenths (1.40) mills for each one-dollar of valuation which amounts to fourteen cents (\$0.14) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, and an increase of six-tenths (.6) of a mill for each one-dollar of valuation which amounts to six cents (\$0.06) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a total of two (2) mills for each one-dollar of valuation which amounts to twenty cents (\$.20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation.
- c. The submission of the question of said renewal levy and decrease is authorized by Sections 5705.03, 5705.19(I), (J) and (JJ), 5705.191, 5705.192, and/or 5705.25 of the Revised Code.
- d. The term of the tax shall be for five (5) years (see Section 5705.19).
- e. The territory where the tax is to be levied shall be the entire territory of Medina Township, Medina County, Ohio.

- f. The date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot is November 2, 2021.
- g. The territory where the ballot measure is to be submitted is the entire territory of Medina Township, Medina County, Ohio.
- h. The tax year in which the tax will first be levied is 2022 and the calendar year in which the tax will first be collected is 2023.
- i. The Township has territory in Medina County and in no other county.

Section 2. This Board requests, in accordance with Section and 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, that the Medina County Auditor certify to this Board the following:

- a. The total current tax valuation of the Township, and
- b. The dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal levy and increase specified in Section 1.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 5705.03(B)(1) the Township Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the Medina County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board or committees, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption.
