Police Lieutenant Job Description

FLSA STATUS: Exempt

**SUPERVISION:** Reports to the Chief of Police

JOB SUMMARY: Under general supervision of the Chief of Police, performs a variety of duties associated with administering field operations, patrol and investigations. Exercises full supervision over several sworn and non-sworn employees. Assumes control of all departmental operations and services in the absence of the Chief of Police. Oversees and participates in the enforcement of Federal, State, and Local laws and implements and enforces departmental policies and procedures. Provides public safety for the citizens of the community. Ensures compliance with administrative procedures and instructions and oversees the daily operations of the police department. Assists in strategic and long-range planning for the police department.

Obtains, disseminates, and exchanges information and communicates efforts and activities of the police department with other law enforcement agencies, staff, other departments, and the public. Contributes to the development, preparation and presentation of the department budget. Provided back-up and support to the Chief of Police. Ensures employees of the department receive the training and equipment needed to safely complete assignments. Mentors and assists in the training of subordinate staff. Coordinates the operation and management of related technologies to maximize interoperability of related police components.

Oversees the performance of subordinate staff and provides input for evaluations. Provides counseling, problem solving and conflict resolution to staff. Attends conferences and meetings to keep abreast of current trends in the field; represents the Medina Township Police Department in a variety of local, county, state, and federal meetings. Cooperates with local, county, state, and federal law enforcement officers as appropriate where activities of the police department are involved. Assists the Chief of Police in ensuring that laws and resolutions are enforced and that the public peace and safety is maintained.

Knowledge of Medina Township resolutions, state, and federal laws; content and intent of Ohio criminal law: adult and juvenile judicial procedures; civil and constitutional laws; principles of supervision and progressive discipline; laws of arrest and search and seizure; techniques of interview and interrogations; criminal case preparation; rime scene management; oral and written communication skills. Prepare clear and concise written reports; communicate

effectively, both orally and in writing; assign and review work of subordinates while maintaining professional working relationship; analyze dangerous situations and effectively identify a safe course of action to resolve the conflict; exercise authority in a positive manner while maintaining strict discipline within the department; meet established timelines and praise good work by subordinates.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be able to work effectively with superiors, subordinates, and colleagues. Possess a high school diploma or equivalent; college degree preferred and/or 5 years of law enforcement experience at the rank of sergeant or above. Completion of advanced leadership/executive courses such as PSLA, CLEE, or F.B.I.N.A is preferred. Must be certified through the Ohio Pease Officer Training Council and have an active police commission. Must have a valid Ohio Driver's license and be able to be insured through Medina Township. Must successfully complete a one-year probationary period, must maintain State mandated and departmental firearms qualification and continuing professional training. Must not have any felony convictions. Must not have any misdemeanor convictions involving offenses of domestic violence. Must maintain LEADS and OHLEG access credentials. Must exercise appropriate confidentiality and cooperation so as not to undermine a duty of loyalty and close working relationships amongst supervisors when the lack of confidentiality and cooperation would detract from or disrupt the effective operation of the agency.

ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The following tasks and duties are intended to be indicative of the daily activities of a lieutenant. It is not intended to be <u>all-inclusive</u>, due to continuing developments in criminal procedures, investigation techniques, and service demands placed on the Medina Township Police Department. It should be further noted that these duties and tasks are carried out under hazardous conditions (occasionally) including, but not limited to inclement weather, heavy traffic, hostile or combative subjects, witnesses, and complainants; non-traditional work hours, darkness, biohazards, including body fluids, environmental and hazardous material disasters, and multiple pressing service demands. The lieutenant is responsible for setting a tone of professionalism, safety, effort and service for all personnel.

It is also important to recognize that failure to properly execute these duties and responsibilities can result in serious injury or death to self and others. Such failure may also result in criminal, civil and administrative sanctions.

The Lieutenant is responsible for meeting the Job Description Administrative Duties and Responsibilities of a Medina Township Police Lieutenant.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR POLICE LIEUTENANT: Lieutenants are expected to keep themselves in physical condition sufficient to engage in strenuous physical activity, involving lifting, strength, endurance and flexibility.

- 1. Lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling (strength). Example: Lifting objects or persons, without assistance, in excess of 100 pounds, dragging a person to safety, pushing a suspect.
- 2. Climbing and/or balancing. Climbing: Ascending or descending ladders, stairs, scaffolding, ramps, into and onto roofs of buildings using the feet and legs and/or hands and arms. Example: Searching a crime scene, climbing a fence. Balancing: Maintaining body equilibrium to prevent falling when walking, standing, crouching or running on narrow, slippery or erratically moving surfaces, as well as uneven ground and inclines. Example: Pursuing a running suspect, handcuffing a prone suspect, entering or exiting a cruiser.
- 3. Stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling and/or returning to standing. Stooping: Bending the body downward and forward by bending the spine at the waist. Example: To examine a VIN plate of a vehicle. Kneeling: Bending the legs at the knees to come to rest on the knee or knees. Example: To assist a collapsed person. Couching: Bending the body downward and forward by bending the legs and spine. Example: To take cover from gun fire Crawling: Moving about on the hands and knees or hands and feet. Example: To pass underneath a fence. Returning to standing: From a stooped/kneeling/crouched/crawl position, return to standing without assistance of any object. Example: Stand-up after handcuffing a prone suspect.
- 4. Reaching, handling, fingering an/or feeling. Reaching: Extending the hands and arms in any direction. Example: To pick up items of evidence. Handling: Seizing, holding, grasping, turning or otherwise working with either hand or both hands (fingering not involved). Example: To operate a portable radio. Fingering: Picking, pinching, or otherwise working with fingers primarily (rather than with the whole hand or arm as in handling). Example: To load bullets into the magazine of one's duty weapon. Feeling: Perceiving such attributes of objects and materials as size, shape, temperature or texture by means of receptors in the skin, particularly those of the fingertips. Example: Detecting contraband in the clothing of prisoners.
- 5. Talking and/or hearing. Talking: Expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word. Example: Advising a suspect of his MIRANDA warnings. Hearing: Perceiving the nature of sounds by the ear. Example: Listening for an audible alarm to locate the source.
- 6. Seeing. Obtaining impressions through the eye of the shape, size, distance, motion, color or other characteristic of objects. The major visual functions are Acuity, far and near. Example: Reading a license plate on a vehicle, reading the serial number of a recovered item. Depth perception, Example: Estimating distances between crash sites and landmarks. Field of vision, Example: Detects movements of hidden suspect on periphery of sight. Acclamation, Example: Can quickly perceive nearly nearby broken windows & further off running suspect. Color Vision, Example: Can distinguish vehicle colors in daylight and artificial light.

- 7. Taste and smell. Can distinguish between odors or scents. Example: Can recognize the smell of alcoholic beverage on suspect's breath.
- 8. Walk, run and sprint. Walk move at a regular pace by lifting and setting down each foot in turn, never having both feet off the ground at the same time. Example: Patrol various areas on foot by walking for 0 consecutive minutes. Run move at a speed faster than a walk, never having both feet on the ground at the same time. Example: Respond to a violent crime in progress, back-up another officer. Sprint run at full speed for 100-400 meters. Example: Chasing a suspect on foot.

**ATTENDANCE:** Demonstrates regular and predictable attendance. Must be available to work Saturdays, Sundays, evenings, nights, and holidays. Must be available for recall with little advanced notice. Must not demonstrate a pattern of unplanned absences. Must attend work reliably. Must set an example for prompt and reliable attendance.

**SUPERVISION:** Supervises patrol officers, sergeants and other subordinate staff in their duties. Prioritizes and coordinates responses to calls for service. Supervises the scheduling and coordinating of shift changes, days off, and sick leave. Reviews and approves a variety of police related reports prepared by subordinate officers or others. Has subordinates correct report and paperwork when necessary. Evaluates officer's arrests based on circumstances and evidence to determine whether subject will be detained or placed in jail.

Supervises, directs, controls, motivates, leads, plans, organizes, delegates, reports, staffs, and communicate with subordinates. Carries out orders from the chief of police. Ability to effectively communicate with the chief of police. Reviews the schedules and reports/corrects any personnel shortages noted or anticipated. Males day-to-day police assignments as required by the needs of the department. Makes plans about individual tactical matters such as equipment to be used for operations or the detailed plans needed for an investigation. Develops new approaches to investigate problems. Advises supervisors on deployment of personnel during emergency response. Maintains contact with all police personnel to coordinate investigation activities, provide mutual assistance during emergency situations and provide general information about department activities. Maintains contact with general public, prosecutors, court officials, and other persons as assigned by the chief of police. Conducts periodic performance evaluations, planning and goal setting sessions with their assigned personnel. Counsels assigned personnel on job performances and disciplinary matters. Prepares and maintains proper documentation detailing performance of subordinates. Works to obtain or sustain superior performance in subordinates.

Personally, participates in investigating criminal law violations occurring with the township limits, obtaining evidence and compiling information regarding these crimes, preparing reports for filing of charges, testifying in court, and related activities. Ability to work a shift in the performance of police patrols, supervision, traffic control, investigation and first aid at accidents, and the detection, investigation and arrest of persons involved in crimes or misconduct. Maintains availability by radio or telephone for consultation on police matters. Carries out duties in conformity with Federal, State, County, laws, and Township resolutions, policies and procedures, rules and regulations. Properly monitors and supervises all vehicle pursuits when available. Responds to the scene of the pursuit as necessary. Stops pursuits when the public and/or pursuing officers are placed in excessive danger. Assists citizens with such matters as locked or stalled vehicles., crime prevention, drug resistance, traffic safety, etc.

Ability to patrol township streets, parks, commercial and residential areas to preserve the peace and enforce the law, control vehicular traffic, prevent, detect and investigate misconduct involving misdemeanors, felonies and other law violations and to otherwise serve and protect the community.

Ability to respond to emergency radio calls and investigates accidents, robberies, civil disturbances, domestic disputes, fights, drunkenness, missing children, prowlers, abuse of drugs, etc. Takes appropriate law enforcement action. As soon as practical, delegates law enforcement activities and prioritizes on-scene supervisory role; establishing on-scene command and utilizing available resources to achieve a clearly established goal.

Ability to interrogate suspects, witnesses and drivers; preserve evidence, arrest violators, investigate and renders assistance at scene of vehicular accidents, summons ambulances, and other law enforcement vehicles. Conduct follow-up investigations of crimes committed during assigned shift, seek out and question victims, witnesses and suspects; develop leads and tips; search crime scenes and gather evidence; arrest offenders and prepare cases for prosecution and testify in court proceedings.

Prepares and reviews a variety of reports and records including officer's initial report, supplements, daily log, report of investigation, field interrogation reports, OVI reports, vehicle impound and inventory reports, overtime reports, sick leave requests, and injury to officer reports.

Identifies exceptional subordinate performance and either recognizes the subordinate performance personally or recommends the subordinate for formal recognition. Coordinates and supervises the training, assignments, and development of sergeants, patrol officers, and other subordinates. Handles or assists in handling any intra-shift problems at the request of supervising sergeant. Handles or assists in handling any problems with other shifts or employees at the request of the supervising sergeant, Monitors and enforces police department harassment policy.

Documents and reports violations to the chief of police. Coordinates activities with supervisors or other township departments, exchange information with officers in other law enforcement agencies, and obtains advise from the prosecutor regarding cases.

**PERIPHERAL DUTIES:** Analyzes and recommends improvements to equipment and facilities, as needed. Reviews, evaluates and develops programs, policies and procedures for various departmental operations. Assists in the preparation and administration of the department budget. Schedules and conducts meetings. Maintains departmental equipment, supplies, and facilities. Maintains liaison with community groups. Ability to train and supervise subordinate personnel. Ability to perform work requiring good physical condition. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with subordinates, peers, supervisors and the general public. Ability to exercise sound judgement in evaluating situations and in making decisions. Ability to follow and give verbal and written instructions. Serve as the acting chief of police in the chief's absence and when so directed by the police chief. Conduct periodic inspections of division personnel and equipment.

**EQUIPMENT AND TECHNOLOGY USED:** Police and other vehicles, police radios, mobile data terminals, computers, printers, computer mouse, CA D system, various departmental software, radar, taser, duty weapon and other weapons as required.

The duties listed above are intended only as illustrations of the types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific job duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

The information contained or requested herein is subject and subordinate to all federal, state, and local rules, regulations and policies as they may be adopted from time to time.

### POLICE LIEUTENANT AGREEMENT

This employment agreement is made and entered into this 23 day of December, 2021 in Medina Township, Ohio by and between the Board of Trustees of Medina Township with offices at 3799 Huffman Road, Medina, Ohio (hereinafter "Board") and Lid Zieja (hereinafter "Police Lieutenant") pursuant to and in accordance with Township Resolution Number 12132021-086 A adopted by the Board at a public meeting. The parties agree that Todd Zieja shall perform the duties of Police Lieutenant of the Medina Township Police Department and hereby agree as follows:

### TERMS OF AGREEMENT

The Board hereby employs **Todd Zieja** as Police Lieutenant of the Medina Township Police Department as an at-will employee, beginning on the <u>37</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2021. The Police Lieutenant shall serve a 1-year probationary period and will receive supervision from the Chief of Police. If for any reason the Chief of Police, Board of Trustees, and/or Designated Police Commissioner feel the need to abolish the Police Lieutenant position or remove the Police Lieutenant from the position with just cause. The Police Lieutenant shall be allowed to return to his/her previous rank and pay without the loss of any seniority, and upon approval of a majority vote of the Medina Township Board of Trustees.

### **DUTIES**

The Police Lieutenant shall faithfully perform the usual and customary duties of the position, including but limited to all statutory duties and responsibilities as specified in the Police Lieutenant job description for the position., in their present form or as amended from time to time. The existing job description is attached as Exhibit A, and hereby incorporated into this agreement by reference as if fully restated herein. The Police Lieutenant's duties will generally be performed during normal business hours, but it is expressly agreed that the duties of this position will require the Police Lieutenant to work at times other than normal business hours. The Police Lieutenant agrees that he/she can perform, and fully complete all duties in the Police Lieutenant Job Description. The Police Lieutenant hereby agrees to devote his/her time, skills, labor, and attention to said employment. The Police Lieutenant agrees to avoid engaging in other income-producing activities, which negatively impact on the performance of his/her duties as Police Lieutenant. All incoming producing activities must be pre-approved by the Chief of Police and Board of Trustees.

### COMPENSATION

The Board, in consideration of the services to be rendered by the Police Lieutenant, hereby agrees to pay the Police Lieutenant a salary at an annual rate of \$80,000 per year. The Board will look to increase the Police Lieutenant salary each year if re-appointed to the position.

### OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Police Lieutenant shall inform the Chief of Police of any personal activities which may interfere or conflict with the job and offices held with associations beyond those normally expected by the job description.

### BENEFITS

The Board shall provide the Police Lieutenant with all benefits provided for non-union at-will, administrative staff employed by the Board, as set forth in the Medina Township Employee Handbook, as it may be amended from time to time, except that:

- 1. The Police Lieutenant shall not receive any compensatory and/or flex time for any hours worked in excess of 40 hours per-week or 80 hours bi-weekly.
- 2. The Police Lieutenant shall be entitled to the same Vacation, Sick Leave, Bereavement, Longevity, Health Insurance and/or including (opt-out payments), Line of Duty Injury Leave, Layoff and Recall, and Retirement as provided to officers and sergeants in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- 3. The Police Lieutenant shall receive a clothing allowance of \$1,500 per calendar year.
- 4. The Police Lieutenant shall receive and recognize (10) paid Holiday Leave according to the Medina Township Employee Handbook (Section 6.3 Holiday Leave).
