ARPA FUNDING DISCUSSION

DISCUSSION	Mr. Johnson introduce the Board of Trustees. Mr. Eastwood
.46 minutes	then introduced Mr. Greg Beck, welcomed him, and thanked
	him for coming to the meeting. Mr. Eastwood asked Mr.
	Beck for guidance on the ARPA funding, the purpose and the
	dos and don'ts on how to use the funds. Mr. Beck started by
	giving a list of four categories. Mitigation, Premium Pay,
	Revenue Loss and Infrastructure and what purpose they
	each have when using the ARPA funds. Mr. Beck explained
	that Revenue Loss can be used for just about anything like
	roads, water, buildings that serve the community. The
	Township has until December 31, 2024, to spend the ARPA
	funds. Mr. Beck can provide us with guidance through the
	process of using the ARPA funds.

ARPA FUNDING DISCUSSION (continued)

DISCUSSION	Mr. Johnson asked about spending regarding levy funds and
	what to target. Mr. Beck stated that relief of taxes is good
	usage. Mr. Eastwood explained that the Township upgraded
	the Police Department cameras and that there is a
	resolution for in place, and that the equipment was
	purchased using the Townships ARPA funds. The Police
	Department then applied for a grant. The grant was
	accepted and rewarded the funds to the Township. Mr.
	Eastwood asked if the grant money could be put back into
	the Township ARPA funds account? Mr. Beck's response
	was "yes" and he would be happy to give a written opinion
	stating so. The Board and Mr. Beck discussed ways of
	partnering with other entities and how this can enhance the
	lifestyle of Township constituents by using the ARPA funds.
